Praying for the Absolute Destruction of Non-Muslims¹

Question: Regarding going to extremes in supplication by praying for the absolute destruction of every non-Muslim and for them to be removed from existence, what has been legislated about this?

Answer: What is legislated in supplication is to pray against only the transgressors among the non-Muslims. This is because the prophet (صلى الله عليه وسلم), whenever he used to supplicate in prayer, he would specify only the transgressors among them. He would not pray against all of them inclusively. Instead, he would say, for example, “Oh Allah, condemn this person and that tribe.” He would not absolutely include every single person who disbelieves.²
